Project Summary

BSES Yamuna Power Ltd. (BYPL) covers several areas of East and Central Delhi with its power distribution system. Some of the major districts where the company is present include Laxmi Nagar, Chandni Chowk, Paharganj, Mayur Vihar, Nand Nagri, Karkardooma and Patel Nagar. The organization, headquartered in the Karkardooma area of East Delhi has over 14 lakh customers and 14 division offices.

BYPL needed an efficient GIS-based solution to manage its power distribution more effectively.

Esri India offered BYPL a GIS solution to deal with its various business challenges. It integrated this offering with BYPL's existing SAP technology, helping the organization improve the overall process and ensure effective scheme design, creation and examination, etc.

Challenges

BYPL was in need of a robust solution as its existing power distribution system was facing several difficulties including the following:

- It was unable to predict and manage asset damages in different areas
- It had problems with forecasting and managing outages
- There was a lack of transparency in the overall power distribution process
- The power distribution system was not user-friendly
- The system's scheme designing, planning and management was not efficient
- Owing to the time-consuming design process, the labor and work related costs were high

BYPL was additionally facing problems in the deployment of a new process in its power distribution system. Aligning existing users with the new process was in fact one of the key technical issues confronting BYPL.

Solution

Various technologies were used for the development of a GIS-based scheme creation module including the ArcGIS Server and ArcGIS API for JavaScript. As the application used the ArcGIS architecture, the accuracy of its corporate data assets was enhanced in an exponential manner.

Since some of the elements of power distribution such as high tension cables, substations, grids and OH conductors could be analyzed on maps using the GIS system, BYPL was able to design construction work sketches efficiently using the solution. End users were able to receive detailed information associated with material costing, work requests and scheduling by using the work management related tools. Also, visibility for users was enhanced through the integration of the system with communication technologies such as SCADA and AMR.

The solution provided by Esri had the following features:
