

Paper Submission Guidelines

Abstract Submission Guidelines

- The abstract submitted should **not exceed 350 words**. The following details should be included:
 - Author / Presenter Name(s)
 - Presentation Title (10 words or less)
 - Topic Category i.e. Theme
 - Company Name
 - Complete Address, Email and Phone
 - Brief Presenter Biography (100 words or less)
- The abstract should **summarize and indicate the key research / points** that will be further presented. Be sure to **answer these questions**:
 - What problem did you solve with GIS? What advantage did GIS give you?
 - What types of geospatial analysis did you use? Explain how and why?
 - What are your findings or results?
 - How can this project be useful for the audience?
- The submitted abstract should be an **original work on Esri technology, one which has not been published before**.
- Abstract should be based on any one of the **topics mentioned in the list of focus areas this year**. If authors would like to submit papers on a **new theme not included in the list of existing theme, they can write to us at papers@esriindia.com**.
- **Do not include information in your abstract that will not be included in your full paper.**

Upon evaluation of abstracts, **selected authors will be invited to send in their full papers** (in English, not exceeding 5 A4 sized page including tables, figures) and a presentation in the provided template. Each paper would be allocated a time slot of 15-20 minutes for presentation at Esri India User Conference.

Content and Evaluation Guidelines

- All submissions must be in English. **Submitted papers shall be evaluated for quality, originality and relevance** by the technical paper committee. The acceptance of the papers will be based on the review results.
- **All papers must be non-commercial**. At no time is it permissible for presenters to use their time slot to advertise or promote a product, service, or company.
- All papers must adhere to the templates provided.
- The **information you enter is used for publishing purposes**. The papers presented would be hosted online on

Esri India's User Conference website. **Business partners must have a client as the primary presenter.** The presentation must focus on your client's success and how Esri software provided a solution.

- **The registration of the first author of the selected paper is complimentary.**

Terms and Conditions

The submission made by the Applicant must NOT contain:

- Nude, lewd or vulgar material
- Any virus, trojan attack
- Material that violates or infringes another's rights, including but not limited to privacy, publicity or intellectual property rights, copyright patent, plagiarised, trademark, trade secret or other proprietary right of any party.
- Material that promotes racism, hatred or harm against any group or individual or promotes discrimination based on race, sex, religion, nationality, disability, sexual orientation or age.
